Gino A. Canale Memorial Scholarship

The creation of this scholarship began in 2002 with Gino Canale who said he would chair the committee. Shortly after, Mr. Canale died, the lodge decided to continue where he left off and presented the scholarship in his name. All of Mr. Canale's adult life was spent in the field of education with his focus always on student needs. Mr. Canale was Director of Continuing Education at Thomas Nelson Community College and his final years were spent at Norfolk State University before his retirement in 1998.

The purpose of this scholarship is to assist one senior student in achieving their goal of attending a school of higher education. The selection process is based on leadership, community involvement, and academic achievement. This scholarship promotes the importance of education, while providing financial assistance and acknowledging academic achievement. This scholarship also enhances the commitment of the Order Sons of Italy and our Lodge to give back to our community.

The amount of the scholarship will be either \$750 or \$1,000. The applicant will receive the scholarship in a one-payment check made payable to the school that the student elects to attend. The scholarship is a one-time award given in May of the applicant's senior year of high school. The recipient will be awarded the scholarship at a ceremony of the high school's choosing by the Lodge President and / or Committee Chairperson. The recipient will also be invited and presented to the Lodge at a general membership meeting.

All application information will be kept confidential.

The Lodge committee reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship in the following instances:

- The applicant does not attend the institution named in the application
- The applicant fails to notify the Lodge Committee Chairperson of a change in institution selected by returning awarded money to be reissued

In the event the student becomes ill and cannot attend the school of choice beginning in the following August/September time frame, the award will be deferred for a period not to exceed one year.
